Anime, also known as Japanimation, is an art form and a huge part of Japanese culture and entertainment for all ages. This part of Japanese culture is finally becoming more mainstream here in the United States. Fully animated features with character development, Japanese folklore, history, martial arts, science fiction, and visually advanced imagery are all part of Anime. The Anime Club is a place for anyone who is interested in anime, manga, drawing, comics, and cartoons. We will be drawing, doing anime related crafts, playing games, having discussions, and of course, watching anime. This club is for those who enjoy experiencing and learning about Japanese culture through the media of Japan, and seeing its influence on other cultures.

#### **Old Fashion Game Time – Mrs. McGrath**

\$35 - 7 Weeks – 1/15, 1/22, 1/29, 2/12, 2/26, 3/4, 3/11

*Minimum of 10 students needed for program to run. Maximum of 20 students.*

Game Time is a club that gives students the opportunity to socialize and have fun together while playing games. Students will have an opportunity to play board games (Clue, Sorry, Monopoly, etc.) and card games (Uno, Trash, etc.) both cooperatively and competitively. All games will be suitable for a middle school audience.

#### **Net Games – Mr. Riley**

\$30 - 6 Weeks – 1/15, 1/22, 1/29, 2/12, 2/26, 3/4

*Minimum of 12 students needed for program to run.*

Students will participate in Pickleball, Badminton, and Volleyball. There will be King of the Court, as well as single-elimination tournaments.

### **Thursdays:**

#### **7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Dodgeball – Mr. Riley**

\$30 - 6 Weeks – 1/16, 1/23, 1/30, 2/6, 2/13, 2/27

*Minimum of 20 students needed for program to run.*

Students will participate in several variations of dodgeball, including Doctor Dodgeball, Battlefield, Elimination, and Prison Dodgeball.

## **Digital Art with Procreate – Mrs. Mulledy**

\$40 - 8 Weeks – 1/16, 1/23, 1/30, 2/6, 2/13, 2/27, 3/5, 3/12

*Minimum of 10 students needed for program to run.*

In this class we will focus on using Procreate drawing software to create digital art. You will learn to use canvas sizes, appropriate DPI format for printing applications, various drawing tools and layering techniques. You will learn to import and export files, photo editing, cut and paste from multiple sources and integrate into artwork.

**\* Must own a tablet preferably with Procreate drawing application and a stylus, or Apple pen.**
